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3 KEYS TO PRAYERFUL MEDITATION

1

Briefly pray for God's help as you read His Word. Humbly acknowledge your need for this help. Ask God to feed you with His Word. This small act of humility will position you for God's grace. Remember, "God opposes the proud, but he gives grace to the humble." See prayers on page 6 of this booklet.

2

In an unhurried way, read through a pre-selected portion of Scripture. What you are seeking for is prayerful meditation on God's Word. You are seeking to let God feed you with His Word.

- Set aside enough time so you can be unhurried in your reading.
- Have a plan for what you will read.
- Prayerfully meditate as you read.

"Meditating is thinking about, reflecting upon, considering, taking to heart, reading slowly and carefully, prayerfully taking in, and humbly receiving into mind, heart and will that which God has revealed."
